GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Best results are obtained by applying the product to cool, wet soil.

MIXING

Prior to pouring, shake container vigorously, then add the required quantity of Apparent Pilferer 500 Herbicide to water the spray vat while stirring or with agitators in motion. DO NOT mix with other pesticides.

COMPATIBILITY

Apparent Pilferer 500 Herbicide is compatible with a range of knockdown and pre-emergent herbicides and insecticides. The following table provides some recommendations on the suitability of tank mix combinations.

Physical compatibility with Apparent Pilferer 500 Herbicide should be determined prior to mixing with a product not listed in this table, or when mixing Apparent Pilferer 500 Herbicide as a component of a 3-way tank mix.

Always read the product label for the manufacturer's tank mix recommendations to determine individual product compatibility options and correct mixing orders for individual products. If unsure, perform a jar test before proceeding to determine physical compatibility. Physical compatibility does not always guarantee biological compatibility.

Explanatory notes on recommendations

Compatible: Products considered physically compatible with Apparent Propyzamide 500 WG in a two-way mix. **Conditional:** Tank mixes of Apparent Propyzamide 500 WG with the following product may result in nozzle or filter blockage if vigorous agitation in the spray mix unit is not maintained during the entire spray operation.

Not recommended - incompatible: Tank mixes of Apparent Propyzamide 500 WG with the following product is likely to form a slimy residue which can block spray nozzles and filters during application.

** It is not recommended to mix Apparent Propyzamide 500 WG with any products containing *Glyphosate* present as the potassium (K) salt.

Apparent Pilferer 500 Herbicide is a member of the amide group of herbicides with diverse sites of action. For weed resistance management this is a Group 3 herbicide. Some naturally occurring weed biotypes resistant to Apparent Pilferer 500 Herbicide and other amide herbicides may exist through normal genetic variability in any weed population. The resistant individuals can eventually dominate the weed population if these herbicides are used repeatedly. These resistant weeds will not be controlled by Apparent Pilferer 500 Herbicide or other amide herbicides. Since the occurrence of resistant weeds is difficult to detect prior to use, AIRR Apparent Pil Ltd accepts no liability for any losses that may result from the failure of Apparent Pilferer 500 Herbicide to control the resistant weeds. Advice as to strategies and alternative treatments that can be used, should be obtained from your local supplier,

consultant, local Department of Agriculture, Primary Industries Department or an AIRR Apparent representative.

PROTECTION OF LIVESTOCK, WILDLIFE, FISH, CRUSTACEANS AND ENVIRONMENT
